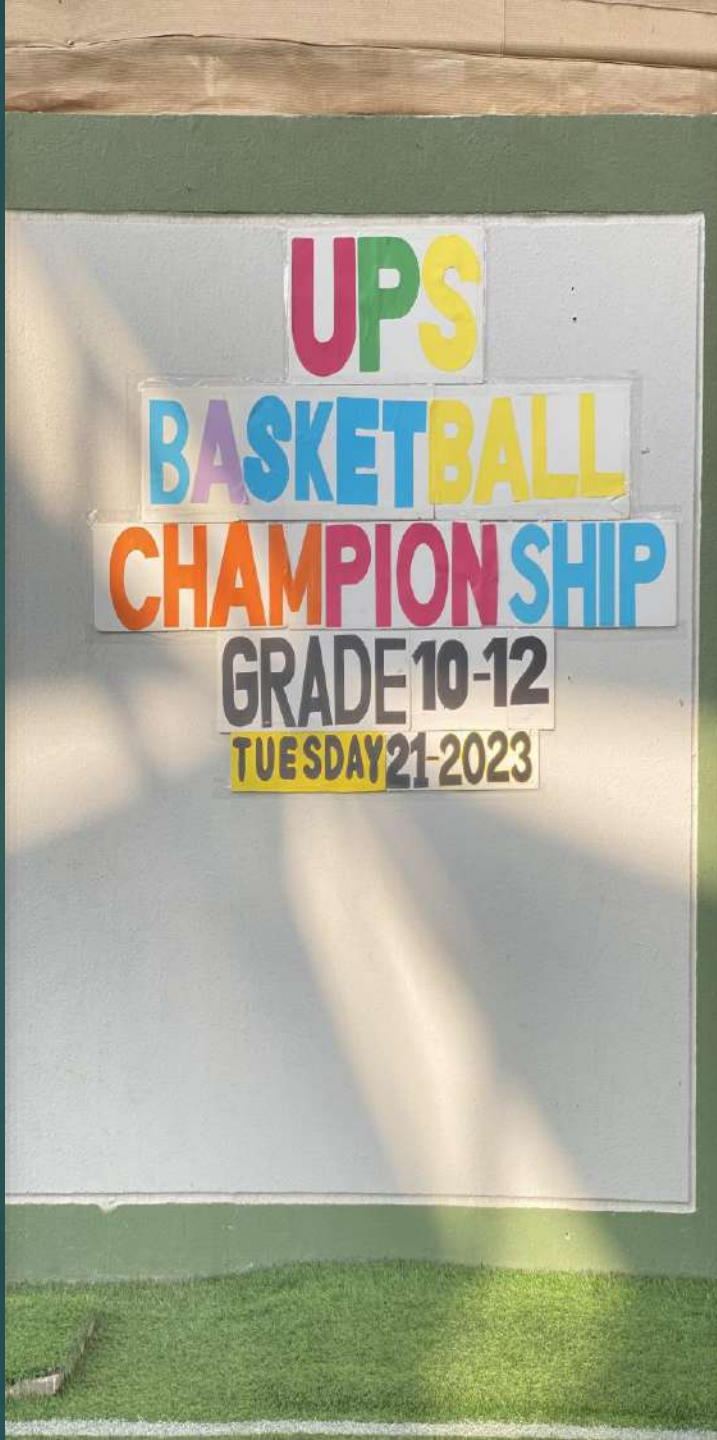

Objective

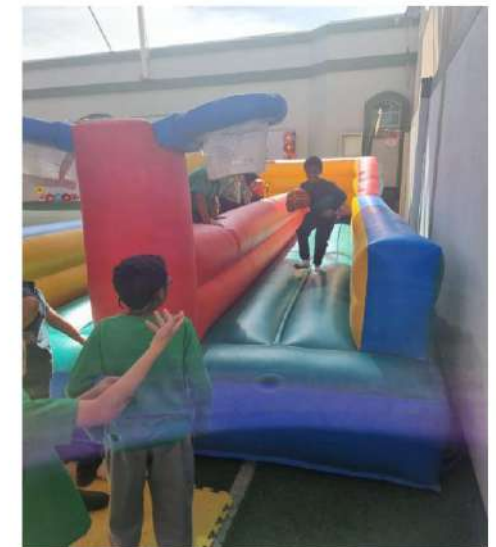
Students' participation in the school sports day activities.

On Jan 25, 2024, the activity department organized the sports day which takes place in the school boys' playgrounds during periods 4, 5, and 6 for grades 3 to 6.

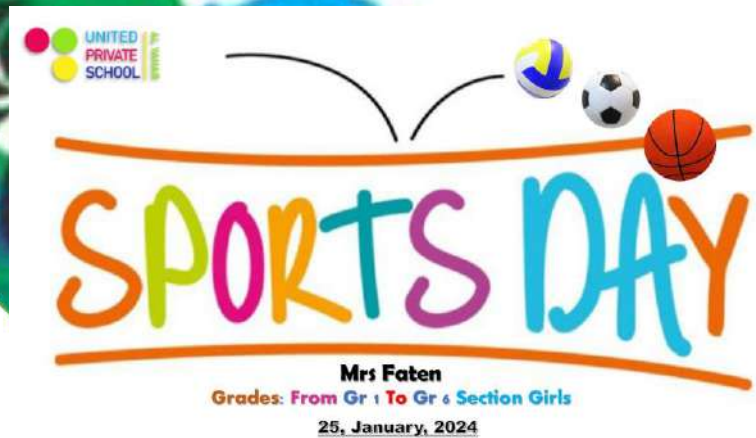
