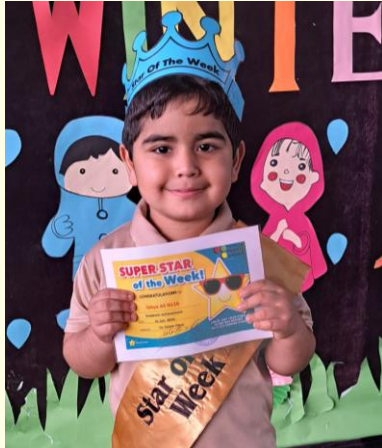


Star of the week
