



GRADUATION POLICY

It is the policy of the school that a senior student who has completed all the requirements for graduation according to the Ministry of Education and ADEC rules shall be qualified for graduation and can participate in the graduation ceremonies.

A. High School Graduation

Requirements

1. Should have obtained a passing grade (60% is the lowest) in the following subjects.
 - English
 - Math
 - Physics
 - Chemistry
 - Biology
 - IT or Business
2. Should have PASSED Arabic & Islamic subjects in the Unified Examination for All Private Schools in the emirates of Abu Dhabi.
3. Should have taken National Examinations – EMSAT (English , Math , Arabic and Physics)
4. A senior with failing grade in any subject at the end of term 3 is afforded every reasonable opportunity to retake tests on specified schedule.

Graduation Fees

The school arranges all necessary requirements for the graduation ceremony and does not collect fees for graduation.

Graduation Ceremony

Every month of June, before the start of summer holidays, a formal ceremony is held for the graduating seniors who choose to participate. This exciting evening feature graduates in caps and gowns and an opportunity to celebrate after the graduation ceremony.

The graduating students are awarded with the following:

1. American Diploma
2. Report Card
3. Souvenir

B. KG 2 Graduation

The School issues diploma at graduation ceremonies that indicate successful completion of all the academic requirements for graduation.

Graduation Ceremony

At the end of May, KG2 graduation is held at a rented auditorium of a school. The graduates in caps and gowns perform on the stage and then receive their diploma.
